



Supplier Development Programme

The Supplier Development Programme (SDP) was established in 2008, and is a partnership of Local Authorities, Scottish Government and other public bodies that work together to bring FREE support in all aspects of tendering to Scottish-based SMEs.

SDP helps businesses that have little or no experience of tendering and are often too small to have dedicated bid/tender resources to contemplate bidding for public sector contracts. SDP aims to help such businesses become what we call "tender ready" for contracts, which improves their prospects when competing for contracts from public bodies throughout Scotland, which includes Scottish Registered Social Landlords e.g. Paisley HA. In conjunction with Scottish local authorities, SDP delivers this support through a Programme of free training and events which can be booked via the SDP website. sdpscotland.co.uk
