Glenburn is a development of 30, 2 and 3 bedroom houses in the Fairway Avenue area of Glenburn. There are also two homes specifically designed for wheelchair users.

The High Calside development is in a beautiful location with fabulous views and suitable for people over 60. There are 16, 1 bedroom (2 apartment) special amenity flats with 4 wheelchair user properties. The new homes have been developed on land owned by PHA which has been in the pipeline for some years.

All properties have now been allocated and tenants will be able to enjoy their new home in time for Christmas.

PHA will be open by appointment to Tenants, Factored Owners and all customers in January 2022!

We will also have most staff operating a new hybrid working pattern of 3 days in Assurance House and 2 days working from home.

To ensure everyone's safety we will have strict measures in place to protect staff and visitors. All visitors will receive information prior to any appointment about our measures in plenty of time to ask questions about what they need to do before, during and after their appointment. If customers prefer a telephone call, online meeting or home visit this is also available. The choice is yours.

Fire Safety

Thanks to everyone who has now had the upgrade to a linked fire alarm system for their home. Unfortunately we still have those who have not co-operated.



This is legislation, just like the legislation that makes you have a Gas Safety check done every year. It is not something that can be ignored by us. Tenant safety is a priority.

Letters are going out to those tenants where we need access with a deadline for the work to be carried out. If the deadline is not met, we will move to formal notification of a Forced Access in order to carry out this legally mandated work.

WE ARE GETTING TENANTS CONNECTED THIS CHRISTMAS

We are delighted to announce we have been awarded funding and devices to assist our vulnerable tenants get connected to the internet.

Thanks to the Scottish Government's Connecting Scotland scheme and additional funding from the Lintel Trust Community Benefit Fund, Paisley HA will be issuing 50 iPads and 15 Chromebooks to vulnerable tenants who need a device to access the internet, we also have a supply of 35 Mobile Internet dongles with free internet, to help those who don't already have internet access.

This is on top of 25 iPads and Internet access that were issued in August 2021 through the Connecting Scotland scheme.

This should provide a great support to our tenants in

accessing essential services such as Universal Credit, applying for jobs or helping their kids do their homework.

We will use these devices to help as many tenants as possible to access the internet. If we are not able to help you this time round, we will keep a note of your details and contact you if we get more devices in the future.
